### **Boys Cross Country**

#### **Number 4**



Lauralton Hall's Kelly Jones competed in her fourth race of the season this week against Hillhouse and West Haven, taking home for fourth straight first-place finish. She ran the Eisenhower Park course in 21:29. She has also won races competing against Foran, Shelton, Amity, Platt Tech, and Wilbur Cross this season.

Sevens are wild for the Cheshire field hockey team. They ran their record to 7-0 on the season with a 7-0 win over Sheehan to close out a two-win week. In their 2-1 win over Hand earlier in the week, Hannah Jalowiec and Elise Hurlbert combined to make, yep, seven saves. Cheshire has allowed only three goals to date this season.
